

Outings:

Membership Application:

In the Membership Application area of the website, you have two options. You may click on the first link to get to a PDF application that you can print before filling out and mailing to us. On the second link, you will get a fillable PDF where you can enter your information directly into the form before printing and mailing it to us. This second link is preferred as it will hopefully eliminate misspellings and illegible handwriting on the printed form.

UPI Products:

This tab on the website is temporarily under construction. The long term idea is to be able to buy UPI merchandise through the website but the logistics as far as costs and methods of mailing merchandise have not been worked out, so the tab is not ready to be used. Hopefully, we will be able to use this function in the future.

Talk-N-Trade:

This tab is similar to the tab on the original website. One nice feature on the new website is that you can receive a notification via email when someone responds to your post. This will eliminate the need to check back to the Talk-N-Trade page to see if you have received any responses. Also, I have heard that several members wanted to add items for sale into the newsletter to gain more exposure. While this is a nice feature, the increased costs of printing the newsletters make the additional pages to list items for sale cost-prohibitive. I encourage members to use the Talk-N-Trade forum to list items you would like to sell.

Photo Gallery:

This new tab will include photos from past UPI events and outings. The volume of photos I acquired when I became president makes this process a work in progress. I encourage you to check out this tab weekly or monthly if you would like to see photos of past UPI events.

Original Website:

This section contains most of the items and pages from the original design of the website. Several functions no longer work, such as the members-only sign in, the claims details, and the original Contact Us page. These functions have been revised and exist in their new formats in other sections of the website.


