





Guests must sign a Guest Release of Liability and Assumption of All Risks, a copy of which is available in you Membership Claims and Rules Guide Book or at our UPI website. We do welcome and encourage guests to attend monthly Chapter meetings. This gives folks a good opportunity to meet UPI members and get an insight to our organization to see if they are interested in joining.

And lastly, remember, the more dirt you dig, the more gold you'll get, but, please remember to be respectful. Fill your holes and leave the land and vegetation as you found it. Have fun out there and hope to see you at Coulterville.
