

Hello!

The April outing at our Bull Creek claim went well, and several club members found a decent amount of gold. Saturday morning saw 11 metal detectorists vying for close to \$300.00 in prizes. The weather wasn't too hot and most of the targets were found . We had six people either renew their memberships, or sign up for the first time. The afternoon's potluck was well-attended and we had about 32 people who came to the outing. The main drawing had 41 gold nuggets, along with an assortment of new and used treasures. After the drawing, an Easter egg hunt was held where club members searched in a field for Easter eggs with only a bag and a flashlight. The 50 planted eggs each contained a ticket that the hunters would turn in for some valuable, and some not-so-valuable prizes. It seemed like most if no all of the attendees enjoyed the outing, and if you weren't able to make it, you missed a good time!

The June outing in Antioch went well also. We wanted to have an outing close to home as we know a lot of members would rather not drive 2-4 hours to an outing at our claims. We started out the morning having a metal detecting hunt with 23 hunters, and gave away close to \$300.00 in prizes. A CD Toss For Gold was added after the hunt prizes were distributed, and that seemed like a big hit for those who participated. We had several folks show up after the hunt for the potluck and main drawing. We gave away 40+ gold nuggets plus another 60+ prizes in the main drawing. Everyone received at least one main drawing prize with most of the folks going home with multiple treasures!
