



# UNITED PROSPECTORS INC. FROM YOUR PRESIDENT


I know I am not the only one thinking it is time to get out of the house and enjoy the fresh air. A trip to the one of the mining claims is a great way to do that. There are many to choose from and I for one plan on hitting as many different claims as I can. Recently I went out to Dry Diggings after one of our members called their local chapter leader with concerns about a honeybee swarm on the claim. I had originally gone out several weeks back to look for the swarm with no luck in locating it and reported to the chapter leader and the claims manager that the swarm was not there. I also found that the mine shaft at the front of the claim was full to the top with water and it did not take long for me to decide that I needed to come back at a later date to do some sampling.

On the most recent trip to Dry Diggings, I arrived around mid day and I could see a few honeybees flying around on the hillside about 15 feet up the hillside above the drainage. As it turns out there now is a honeybee colony living in the hollow portion of an oak tree on the side of the hill. I was able to walk right up to it and observe it for several minutes without the bees becoming agitated. It is far enough out of the way that it poses no threat to us and should be left alone. It is also surrounded by lots of poison oak that has yet to leaf out. If bees make you nervous or you are allergic to bees, you may want to avoid that claim. I for one was glad to see a wild hive surviving.

There will be outings scheduled this year and with any luck the state and counties will let us keep them scheduled. For the time being the Saturday night potluck dinners will be on hold. We will resume the detector hunts and possibly a few other games and activities. The dates for the outings are in the newsletter and on the Talk and Trade section of the webpage. We are going to try to get into Genesee later this year. If that is not possible then we will move that outing to Twain if possible. There will be updates on this in future newsletters as we get closer to that outing.




